

Disposal of ContraPest®

ContraPest's disposal process is simple.



IF TANK IS EMPTY

Place container in trash or offer for recycling.

NOTE: Do not re-use empty tanks.



IF PARTLY FILLED

Cap the tank and place in the trash container or recycling.



WHY SO SIMPLE?

The EPA performed a risk assessment and reviewed the disposal procedure provided on the label when ContraPest was registered and found that the procedure was sufficient because of the following:

- Low concentration of Active Ingredients, less than 0.1%
- The remaining 99.9% of ContraPest is composed of Generally Recognized As Safe ingredients
