ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Quality Laboratory Technician:

- Responsible for Quality Control Analysis and preparation of samples for data analysis as well as accurate creation and maintenance of batch reporting and documentation per SOP.
- Performs regular equipment calibration and maintenance.
- Maintains production reports and equipment logs.
- Maintains inventory, receipt documentation, and lot analysis of miscellaneous chemicals and Active Ingredients; as well as proper documentation/certification of actives and all materials used in the production of ContraPest®.
- Participation in research projects as needed and as directed by the Vice President of Manufacturing.
- Completes & reviews batch records ensuring the accuracy of the document prior to review by management.
- Tracks trending of processes and/or processing parameters and provides initial evaluation of the data, notifying Manufacturing Manager of trends.
- Reviews work of self and others to ensure accuracy and compliance with Good Documentation Practices.
- Performs laboratory inspections and assists with in-house audits. Responsible for maintaining a clean laboratory space in compliance with GLP practices.
- Responsible for maintaining accurate records using internal tools including laboratory notebooks, MS Excel, Smartsheets, etc.
- Responsible for upkeep and writing of required SOPs.
- Serves as primary contact for outside vendors and service providers for QA/QC and as Safety lead for QA/QC.
- Functions IAW all safety regulations per Company Safety Program.
- Participates in on-going training. Completes annual GMP & safety training.

Occasionally, other responsibilities may include:

- Assist in the production of ContraPest® according to SOPs.
- Assist in performance of set-up, dismantling, and cleaning of equipment used for production operations.
- Assist in training new and existing employees
