ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for making ContraPest® according to SOPs and Batch Record instructions and takes responsibility for manufacturing a quality product.
- Performs set-up, dismantling, and maintenance of equipment and assures equipment is ready for production. Performs routine sanitization of areas.
- Performs equipment maintenance such as periodic equipment cleaning, inspection, and filter changes, etc. Trouble shoots equipment as necessary during production operations.
- Maintains inventory of equipment and supplies and ensures the availability for production activities.
- Complies with SOPs, Batch Records, and other GMP documentation.
- Reviews work of self and others to ensure accuracy and compliance with good documentation practices.
