The Senior Manufacturing Maintenance Technician III will also be providing leadership and direction to new and existing employees for day-to-day production activities. Manufacturing Maintenance Technicians are also responsible for packaging finished goods, moving incoming and outgoing freight, processing daily orders, operating forklifts, shipping products accurately, receiving incoming products on pallets and in boxes, ensuring that production is tidy, clean, and safe.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for making ContraPest® according to SOPs and Batch Record instructions and takes responsibility for manufacturing a quality product.
- Performs set-up, dismantling, and maintenance of equipment and assures equipment is ready for production operations. Performs routine sanitization of areas.
- Performs equipment maintenance such as periodic equipment cleaning, inspection, and filter changes, etc. Trouble shoots and repairs equipment as necessary during production operations.
- Maintains inventory of equipment and supplies and ensures the availability for production activities.
- Complies with SOPs, Batch Records, and other GMP documentation.
- Reviews work of self and others to ensure accuracy and compliance with good documentation practices.
- Training new and existing employees on all aspects of production, shipping, and maintenance job duties.
- Completes & reviews batch records ensuring the accuracy of the document prior to review by management.
- Edit's qualification protocols for new and/or existing equipment or systems
- Participates in trending of processes and/or processing parameters and provide initial evaluation of the data – notifying Manufacturing Manager of trends.
- Recommends scheduling or other efficiency improvements as indicated.
- Conducts manufacturing activities to protect themselves, others, and company assets.
- Participates in on-going training. Completes annual GMP & safety training.
- Cross trains to support other departments.
- Continues SOP training as it pertains to daily tasks & participates in on-the-job training.
- Develops new skills and knowledge which are beneficial to self and SenesTech.
- Identifies process opportunities and offers suggestions.
- Performs day to day on the floor leadership for new and existing employees. This includes providing direction and task assignments for production activities.
